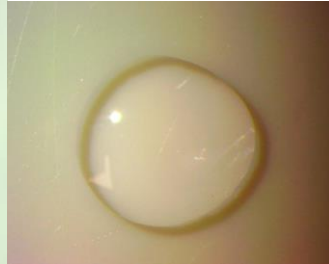

The client sample was analyzed for pesticides using Liquid Chromatography with Mass Spectrometric detection (LC/MS/MS). The method used for sample prep was based on the European method for pesticide analysis (EN 15662).
